## ORDINANCE 2000 - <u>Z3</u> Approval of Final Plat LOTUS RIDGE SUBDIVISION

<u>WHEREAS</u>, William Stepan petitioned Kendall County for approval of a Final Plat of Lotus Ridge Subdivision; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Preliminary Plat of said subdivision was approved on April 20, 1999, as Kendall County Ordinance 99-12; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Condition # 7 of said ordinance states: "The petitioner shall utilize mechanical systems or "prairie grass" septic fields (with means of sewage disposal determined prior to the issuance of a building permit);" and

WHEREAS, said condition may not be technically feasible; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the topography of said subdivision is not conducive to stormwater detention as required by the Kendall County Stormwater Control Ordinance; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Final Plat of said subdivision was recommended for approval by the Kendall County Regional Planning Commission on March 22, 2000; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said Final Plat is in general conformance with the Preliminary Plat and Subdivision Control Ordinances;

<u>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</u>, the Kendall County Board hereby approves the Final Plat for the Lotus Ridge Subdivision, with the following conditions:

- 1. The road name shall be deleted from the Final Plat;
- 2. Addressing shall be in accordance with the Kendall County Subdivision Control Ordinance;
- 3. The IDNR Endangered Species Consultation Report process must be terminated prior to the issuance of a building permit;
- 4. A wetlands delineation shall be conducted prior to the issuance of a building permit; and
- 5. Any modifications to the Final Plat as a result of the studies shall require an amendment to this ordinance.

<u>BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</u>, the Kendall County Board hereby repeals Condition #7 of Kendall County Ordinance 99-12 in its entirety.

<u>BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</u>, the Kendall County Board hereby waives the stormwater requirements of the Kendall County Stormwater Control Ordinance for said subdivision.
