AMENDMENT TO KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE A-1 SPECIAL USE - PRIVATE UTILITIES TEXT AMENDMENT

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Kendall County regulates land uses under the authority of its Zoning Ordinance and related ordinances; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Kendall County Board amends these ordinances from time to time in the public's interest; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance presently does not provide for private electrical utilities as special uses in the A-1 Agriculture District; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance presently allows public electrical utilities as special uses in the A-1 Agriculture District; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, all administrative procedures for amendments have been followed including a Public Hearing held before the Kendall County Zoning Board of Appeals;

<u>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</u>, the Kendall County Board hereby amends Section 7.00 Agricultural Districts; Subsection B. Special Uses; Paragraph 19 of the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance as follows: (Underline=Insert Text & Strikeout=Delete Text)

Public <u>and private utility utilities</u> and <u>public</u> services, including; electric substations; <u>electric central station</u>, <u>power and steam-generating plants</u>; repeater stations; micro-wave relay towers and stations; mobile transmitting tower and stations, antenna towers and other outdoor equipment essential to the operation of exchange in the interest of public convenience and necessity; water filtration plants; water pumping stations; water reservoir and similar uses.
