DOCUMENT FEE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the County of Kendall has adopted ordinances, regulations, and maps which regulate the development and use of land and structures; and

WHEREAS, from time to time persons desire to obtain said ordinances, regulations, maps, or other documents; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the County of Kendall to have those persons obtaining said ordinances, regulations, maps, or other documents pay for the costs associated with reproducing said ordinances, regulations, maps, or other documents; and

WHEREAS, the documents are available from the County Clerk or through the Freedom of Information Act at a reproduction cost of \$0.25 per page; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to standardize the fee charged for each ordinance, regulation, map, or document;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF THE COUNTY OF KENDALL THAT:

SECTION 1: THE FOLLOWING FEE SCHEDULE SHALL APPLY TO EACH PURCHASE OF AN ORDINANCE, REGULATION, MAP, OR OTHER DOCUMENT:

SECTION 2: TIME OF PAYMENT

All fees shall be due and payable at the time of purchase.

SECTION 3: WAIVERS AND REFUNDS

No waiver and no refund shall be made for any fee paid pursuant to this Ordinance without the approval of the Planning, Building, and Zoning Committee of the County Board, EXCEPT, all fees for actions or activities by Kendall County or the Kendall County Forest Preserve District are hereby waived, and, EXCEPT, that all fees for ordinances, regulations, maps, and other documents requested by other units of government are hereby waived, provided that said waiver is reciprocated by that unit of government.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective on October 4, 1999.
