To the Minor and parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s):

The probation officer at this preliminary conference will be asking the minor and parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s) questions about the minor's background, including family, school, employment, friends, and health. After the preliminary conference, the Officer will review the information and meet with you on how the minor's case will be handled.

The following guidelines apply to the preliminary conference:

- 1. You are not required to answer any questions. The information given will help the Officer to make the best decision in the minor's case.
- 2. You may have an attorney present, at your own cost.
- 3. Information given to the Officer cannot be used to find minor guilty in court. It is used to recommend to the Judge what should happen to the minor if the minor admits or is found guilty of the charge(s). It is used during the dispositional phase.
- 4. If you prefer to have the case sent to Court and do not wish to answer any questions, notify the Officer NOW and this meeting will end.
