AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 95-10 GRANTING AN A-1 BUILDING PERMIT

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Edward and Kimberly Brengman did petition Kendall County in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for an A-1 Building Permit pursuant to Section 7.01A.2.c. of the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois did grant the petitioners an A-1 Building Permit under Ordinance 95-10 on June 20, 1995; and

WHEREAS, a clerical error caused Ordinance 95-10 to conflict with the original petition;

<u>THEREFORE</u>, <u>BE IT ORDAINED</u> by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the legal description in Ordinance 95-10 be replaced by the following text:

That part of the Waish-Kee-Shaw Reservation described as follows: Commencing at a point on the South line of the North half of said reservation which is 548.0 feet easterly of the southeast corner of Arrowhead Hills, Unit No. Two; thence northerly along a line forming an angle of 89°32'00" with said south line, measured from West to North, 1,513.64 feet (this line hereinafter referred to as Line A); thence westerly, parallel with said South line, 488.00 feet; thence northerly, parallel with said Line A, 40.00 feet for a point of beginning; thence northerly, parallel with said Line A, 1,153.17 feet to a point which is 560.0 feet southerly, as measured parallel with said Line A, of the North line of said reservation; thence easterly, parallel with said North line, 467.98 feet; thence northerly, parallel with said Line A, 560.0 feet to said North line; thence easterly along said North line, 20.00 feet to said Line A extended from the South; thence southerly along said extended Line A, 1,716.31 feet to a line drawn easterly, parallel with said South line, from the point of beginning; thence westerly parallel with said South line, 488.00 feet to the point of beginning in Oswego and Na-Au-Say Townships, Kendall County, Illinois and containing 13.194 acres.

<u>ADDITIONALLY</u>, the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois takes this opportunity to apologize to Edward and Kimberly Brengman for the error that has transpired.
