ORDINANCE 98 - 2 9 Approving a Rezoning A-1 to R-3 and Preliminary Plat of Subdivision SCHUBERT

<u>WHEREAS</u>, William Schubert, known as the sole beneficiary of Trust # 3289 of the First National Bank of Joliet, owner, and intended developer, did petition Kendall County for a zoning map amendment from A-1 to R-3 Single Family Residential and a subdivision for 3 single family lots;

<u>WHEREAS</u>, said petitions did pertain to one tract of land approximately 5.2 acres with existing accessory buildings, which shall remain, located along Countryview Drive in Oswego Township; and

- 2. A preliminary plat of subdivision for said tract of land entitled "Zoning Sketch & Preliminary Plat of Part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 26-37-7 and Part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35-37-7 Oswego Township, Kendall County, Illinois," prepared by James M. Olson Associates, LTD.
