ORDINANCE 96 - 18 GRANTING A SPECIAL USE

WHEREAS, Duane D. Hem, et. al did petition Kendall County in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a Special Use in the Agriculture District of the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the required public hearing was held before the Kendall County Zoning Board of Appeals and said Board did recommend granting the request with stipulations;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described 10 acre site be granted a Special Use and be reclassified from A-1 Agriculture District to A-1 Special Use for the purpose of establishing a church facility, church related buildings and a lighted sign and the Zoning Administrator is hereby directed to amend the zoning map to reflect the special use. The following described property is part of a vacant 169 acres parcel with no common address:

That part of the East half of the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 14, Township 37 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian described by the beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of Wolf Road with the West line of the East half of the West half of the Northwest quarter of said Section 14 and proceeding thence South along said West line 725.46 feet; thence East at right angles to the last described course 577.00 feet; thence North, parallel with said West line, 784.42 feet to the center line of Wolf Road; thence Southwesterly along the center line of Wolf Road, 580 feet to the point of beginning, containing 435,600 square feet, all in Oswego Township, Kendall County, Illinois.
