ORDINANCE 95- 10 GRANTING AN A-1 BUILDING PERMIT

WHEREAS, Edward and Kimberly Brengman did petition Kendall County in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for an A-1 Building Permit pursuant to Section 7.01.A.2.c. of the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the required public hearing was held before the Kendall County Zoning Board of Appeals;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described 13 acres shall be granted one A-1 Building Permit:

That part of the Waish-Kee-Shaw Reservation described as follows: Commencing at a point on the South Line of Line of the North Half of said Reservation which is 548.0 feet easterly of the Southeast Corner of Arrowhead Hills, Unit No. Two; thence northerly along a line forming an angle of 89 32' 00" with said South line, measured from West to North, 1513.64 feet (This line hereinafter referred to as "Line A"); thence westerly parallel with said south line, 488.00 feet; thence northerly parallel with said "Line A" aforesaid, 1753.17 feet to the north line of said reservation for a point of beginning; thence southerly along the last described course, 560.0 feet thence easterly, parallel with said north line, 467.98 feet; thence northerly, parallel with said "Line A" 560.0 feet to said north line; thence westerly along said north line, 467.98 feet to the point of beginning, in Oswego Township, Kendall County, Illinois.

ADDITIONALLY, a covenant or deed restriction must be recorded with the following stipulations to be adhered to:

- The owners acknowledge that emergency services may not be available to them 365 days a year due to the condition of the private road.
- 2. There must be adquate road base on the private drive to accommodate emergency vehicles.
- The owners agree there will be no further subdivision of this 13.6 acre property.
