

ORDINANCE
AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED


WHEREAS, Oswego Baptist Church did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and ordinance of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed establishment of a special use as provided by the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed map amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed map amendment on the 10th day of April, 1992 in the Kendall County Board Room and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps be amended; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be granted the special use for building a church and that the Zoning Administrator be hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map to show the special use classification legally described as follows:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 37 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows: beginning at the point of intersection of the east line of said Northwest Quarter with the centerline of Plainfield Road; thence Northwesterly along said centerline, being along a curve to the right, having a radius of 12,277.70 feet for 317.23 feet to a point of tangency (chord 317.22 feet, bearing North 62°07'18" West); thence North 61°22'53" West, along said centerline, 627.77 feet; thence North 28°37'07" East, at right angles to the last described course, 364.67 feet; thence North 62°01'23" East, 468.03 feet; thence North 89°41'19" East, 238.10 feet to said East Line; thence South 00°18'41" East along said east line, 990.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 12.00 acres in Oswego Township, Kendall County, Illinois.
