ORDINANCE NO. 92- 13
ESTABLISHMENT OF CIRCUIT CLERK DOCUMENT STORAGE FUND FEES

WHEREAS, Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 25, Par.27.3c, authorizes the County to establish and maintain a document storage system, the expense of which being borne by the County; and


WHEREAS, the above cited statute allows the County Board to require the Circuit Clerk to collect a court document fee to be paid at the time of filing the first pleading, paper or other appearance filed by each party in all civil cases or by the defendant in any felony, misdemeanor, traffic, ordinance, or conservation matter on a judgment of guilty or grant of supervision, provided that the document storage system is in place or has been authorized by the County Board and further that no additional fee shall be required if more than one party is presented in a single pleading, paper, or other appearance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Kendall County Board as follows:


1. A "Circuit Clerk Document Storage Fund" is hereby established to serve as the repository for the fees pursuant to IRS, Chap 25, par. 27.3c.
2. The Clerk of the Circuit Court shall charge and collect a document storage fee of Five Dollars (\$5). Said fee shall be paid at the time of the first pleading, paper or other appearance being filed by each party in all civil cases or by the defendant in any felony, misdemeanor, traffic, ordinance, or conservation matter on a judgment of guilty or grant of supervision, provided that no additional fee shall be required if more than one party is presented in a single pleading, paper or other appearance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be effective October 1, 1992.
