ORDINANCE

AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED WHEREAS, Rousonelous Farms, Inc., Migrant Head Start, Inc., did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

Whereas, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed map amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed map amendment on the 23rd day of February, 1990 in the Kendall County Board Room and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps be amended; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby reclassified from A-1, Agriculture District to A1SU, Agriculture Special Use for Philanthropic and Elementary Institution and that the Zoning Administrator be hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map to show the change in zoning classification, legally described as follow:

The Northwesterly 2 acres of the southeast quarter of Section 1 (except that part thereof lying Northeasterly of the original center line of Updike Road) in Township 36 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian in the Township of Na-Au-Say, Kendall County, Illinois.
