

ORDINANCE 81-8
AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED


WHEREAS, John and Diane Becker did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 20th day of October, 1981, A.D., on the site described in the petition and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps and ordinance be amended in the manner required by law; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby rezoned from A1, Agricultural District to R2, Single Family District and that the County Clerk be and she is hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map, to show the change in zoning classification:

Part of the North half of the Southwest quarter of Section 36, Township - 37 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian described as follows: Beginning at 89°30'47" thence Easterly 300 feet parallel with the South line of the North half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 36. Thence Southerly 300 feet parallel with the East line of the North half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 36. Thence Westerly 300 feet parallel with the South line of the North half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 36. Thence Northerly 300 feet parallel with the East line of the North half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 36 to the point of beginning in Kendall County, Illinois containing 2 acres more or less.

Part of the North half of the Southwest quarter of Section 36, Township 37 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian described as follows: Commencing at the South-east corner of the North half of the South-west quarter, thence westerly along the South line of said North half of the South-west quarter 939 feet; thence Northerly parallel with the East line of said North half of the South-west quarter 654 feet for the point of beginning. Thence Easterly 300 feet parallel with the South line of the North half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 36. Thence Southerly 300 feet parallel with the East line of the North half of the South-west quarter of said Section 36. Thence Westerly 300 feet parallel with the South line of the North half of the South-west quarter of said Section 36. Thence Northerly 300 feet parallel with the East line of the North half of the South-west quarter of said Section 36 to the point of beginning in Kendall County, Illinois containing 2 acres more or less.
