AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED


WHEREAS, Rose Mary Condon did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed map amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed map amendment on the 1st day of July, 1988 in the Kendall County Board Room and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps be amended; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby reclassified from A1, Agriculture District to R3, Single Family District and that the Zoning Administrator be hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map to show the change in zoning classification, legally described as follows:


That part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 36 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the South line of Government Line No. 2 of said Northwest Quarter with the center line of Cherry Road; thence North 89°06'33" East along said South Line, 806.32 feet; thence North 00°53'27" West, 68.67 feet to the original center line of Oswego-Plainfield Road; thence North 63°22'02" West along said original center line, 909.32 feet to said Cherry Road center line, 488.87 feet to the point of beginning in Na-Au-Say Township, Kendall County, Illinois and containing 5.160 acres.
