AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, James Abhul did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and


WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed map amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed map amendment on the 9th day of September, 1988 in the Kendall County Board Room and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps be amended; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby reclassified from A1, Agriculture District to R2, Single Family District and that the Zoning Administrator be hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map to show the change in zoning classification, legally described as follows:

That part of the Waish-Kee-Shaw Reservation described as follows:
Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 41, Arrowhead Hills, Unit No. 2; thence westerly, parallel with the center line of Reservation Road, being along a line which forms an angle of 89°07'15" with the West line of said lot, measured counter-clockwise therefrom, 246.0 feet; thence southerly, parallel with said West line, 684.02 feet for a point of beginning; thence northerly, parallel with said West line, 305.0 feet; thence westerly, parallel with said center line, 300.0 feet; thence southerly, parallel with said West line 305.0

feet to a line drawn westerly, parallel with said center line, from the point of beginning; thence easterly along said parallel line, 300.0 feet to the point of beginning, in Na-Au-Say Township, Kendall County, Illinois and containing 2.100 acres.
