

ORDINANCE NO.

89 - 24

AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Paul Strong did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed map amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed map amendment on the 24th of July, 1989 in the Kendall County Board Room and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps be amended; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby reclassified from A-1, Agriculture District to R-1, Residential District and that the Zoning Administrator be hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map to show the change in zoning classification, legally described as follows:

The easterly 366.44 feet of the westerly 1077.12 feet of the southerly 356.64 feet (as measured along the southerly and westerly lines) of the Northwest Quarter of Section 19, Township 36 North, Range 7 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Kendall Township, Kendall County, Illinois and containing 3.000 acres.
