Call to Order – The meeting was called to order by Committee Chair Elizabeth Flowers at 8:35a.m.

Roll Call

Committee Members Present: Matt Kellogg - yes, Lynn Cullick - here, Elizabeth Flowers – present, John Purcell – here, Matt Prochaska - here. With five members present, a quorum was established to conduct committee business.

Others present: Scott Koepfel, Laura Pawson, Dr. Gary Schlapp

Approval of Agenda – Motion made by Member Purcell to approve the agenda, second by Member Cullick. With five members in agreement, the motion carried.

Approval of Minutes – Member Prochaska made a motion to approve the September 27, 2017 meeting minutes, second by Member Cullick. With five members in agreement, the motion carried.

Monthly Report – Laura Pawson reviewed the census report with the committee. Written reports provided.

Review and Approval of the Animal Control FY2018 Budget – The committee reviewed the proposed budget. Member Purcell stated that the Finance Committee would discuss the three percent salary increase processed for Animal Control staff at the Finance meeting on Thursday.

Adjournment – Member Prochaska made a motion to adjourn the meeting, second to the motion by Member Purcell. With all in agreement, the meeting was adjourned at 9:34a.m.

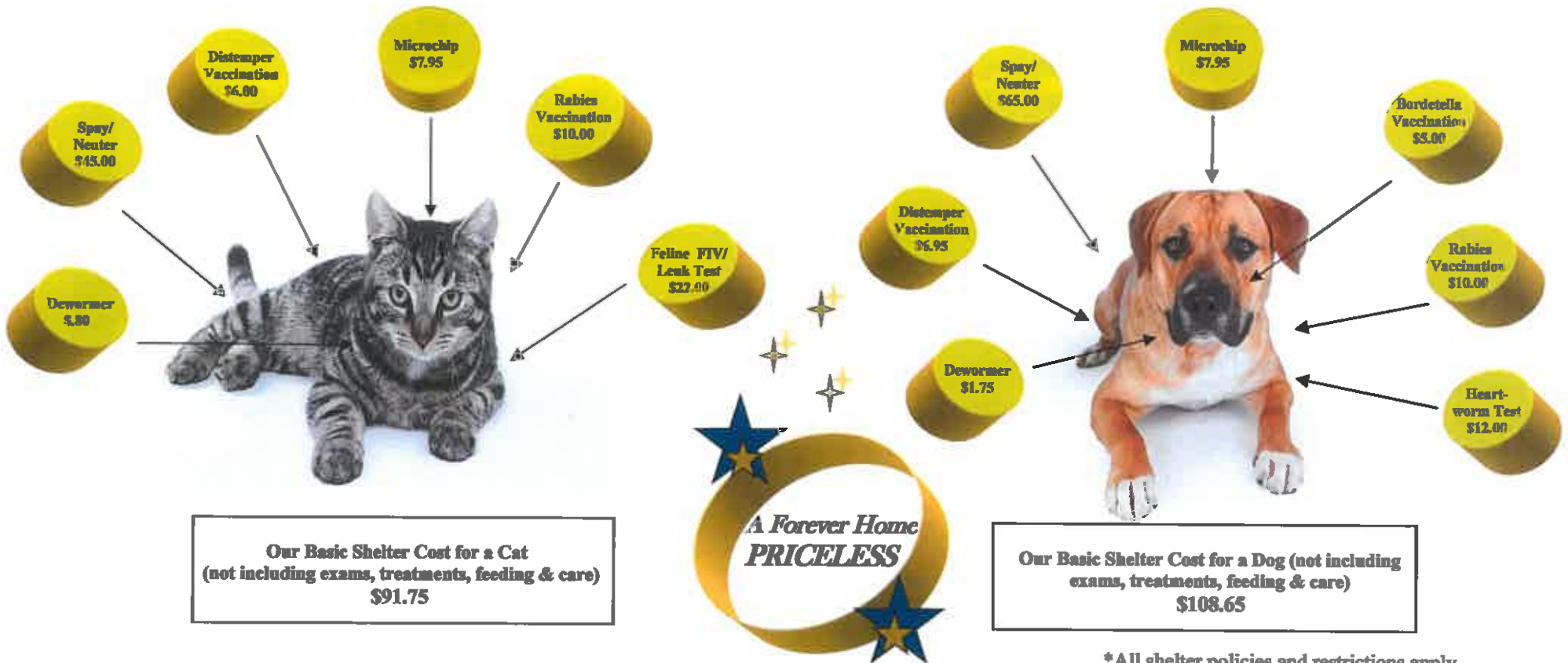

Kendall County Animal Control is the County agency responsible for the enforcement of the state statutes governing rabies control in domestic companion animals. The State of Illinois requires that all dogs be vaccinated against rabies by a licensed veterinarian. Compliance with this law is monitored through the issuance of rabies tags for all dogs residing in the County. All dogs are required to wear their rabies tags when off of the owner's property. If a pet is lost, rabies tags also provide an excellent means of identifying your pet.

Kendall County Animal Control enforces the County's ordinance that prohibits dogs from running at large in unincorporated, residential areas. Animal Control also reports animal bites as well as pick up stray dogs that are in a contained area. Stray dogs may also be brought to the facility during business hours. Dogs and cats are available for adoption at our facility.

October Summary

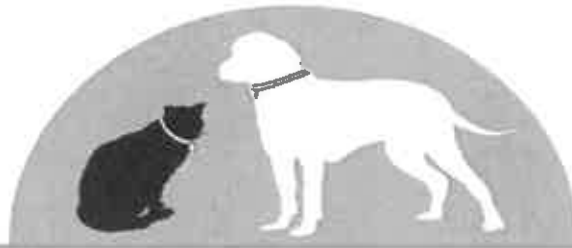

Funds from the \$10 set aside of the differential under Section 3 of this Act that is placed in the county animal population control fund may only be used to (1) spay, neuter, vaccinate, or sterilize adopted dogs or cats; (2) spay, neuter, or vaccinate dogs or cats owned by low income county residents who are eligible for the Food Stamp Program or Social Security Disability Benefits Program; or (3) spay, neuter, and vaccinate feral cats in programs recognized by the county or a municipality. This Section does not apply to a county with 3,000,000 or more inhabitants.
