Ms. Pawson reported that five people attended the volunteer orientation on January 19, 2016, and that there will be an Adoption event the second Saturday of each month at Pet Supplies Plus

Operations Report – Ms. Pawson provided an update on the potbelly pigs previously held at the facility pending litigation with the owner, and stated that Animal Control was called out again to contain one female pig, and one baby pig in the Plano area recently. The animals were transported to Kendall County Animal Control, and after the owner forfeited ownership in court, all of the pigs were turned over to the Hooved Animal Humane Society in Woodstock.

Mr. Wilkins received confirmation from the City of Yorkville that a mobile trailer would be authorized as an accessory structure near the Animal Control facility, and would only need City permits. Mr. Wilkins will inquire about zoning requirements for a covered walkway, or connection between the trailer and the main facility, and report at the next meeting. The plan for the trailer is to serve as the administrative offices for Animal Control.

<u>Accounting Report</u> – Jeff Wilkins provided an overview of the monthly financial report with the committee, and stated that we are on track with expenses, and transfers. Mr. Wilkins said that December was a negative month overall, but the fund balance is still at a healthy level.

Other Business

> Review Organization Chart – Mr. Wilkins reviewed the proposed organizational chart with the committee. There was discussion on adding the number of volunteers to the current chart. Member Purcell made a motion to forward the organizational

chart with the addition of volunteers to the chart, to the Admin HR Committee for approval, second by Member Flowers. With all in agreement, the motion carried.



making him feel so much more comfortable. Mickey was very scared and shy for the first couple weeks, but with patience and lots of TLC Mickey started to show us his sweet personality. He loved to be held and cuddled by the staff but was still very scared of strangers. We decided the best thing for Mickey was to find a foster based rescue where he may feel more comfortable in a home setting until a forever home could be found. Kendall County Animal Control is the County agency responsible for the enforcement of the state statutes governing rabies control in domestic companion animals. The State of Illinois requires that all dogs be vaccinated against rabies by a licensed veterinarian. Compliance with this law is monitored through the issuance of rabies tags for all dogs residing in the County. All dogs are required to wear their rabies tags when off of the owner's property. If a pet is lost, rabies tags also provide an excellent means of identifying your pet.

Kendall County Animal Control enforces the County's ordinance that prohibits dogs from running at large in unincorporated, residential areas. Animal Control also reports animal bites as well as pick up stray dogs that are in a contained area. Stray dogs may also be brought to the facility during business hours. Dogs and cats are available for adoption at our facility.

Labradors are No. 1 dog breed in Kendall County

Breed most popular according to county animal control records

The Labrador retriever reigns supreme as the most popular dog in Kendall County.

According to the County Animal Control facility, the most popular dog last year was the Labrador retriever followed by the Shih Tzu, Yorkshire terrier, German shepherd and boxer rounding out the top five.

Other breeds on the county's top ten list include pit bulls, Chihuahuas, beagles and Siberian huskies at number 10.

The facility issued almost 9,500 oneyear rables tags and about 4,000 three-year rables tags in 2015 for a total of over 13,000 rables tags issued.

The state of Illinois requires dog owners to purchase tags for their dogs through their local county animal control facility. Most veterinarians offer the tags at their offices.

The tags show the dog has had its rables vaccine and can be used to help locate the dog's owner. There is an annual vaccine and one required every three years.

The number of tags has been increasing over the last five years and it might be based on better owner compliance or more animals being purchased in the county. Vets also purchase the tags through Animal Control and make them available to their customers.


Oswego does not have a cap on the number of animals residents are allowed to own, which could be one reason the village is at the top of the list in terms







of tags issued. The city of Yorkville caps pet ownership at four dogs or cats per household, according to local city ordinance.



Registering your dog is also important because it helps Animal Control identify them, especially if they are prone to getting out.

"It's an excellent way to identify a pet if they get lost," said Laura Pawson, Animal Control director. "Sometimes we have residents who will find a dog and that way they don't have to bring the animal here. If it has identification they can call us, we make the phone call and we reunite the animal without bringing it here to animal control."

If the dog is wearing tags, Animal Control employees can input the registration code into their database and look up its owner. Additionally, owners can opt to have their pet implanted with a microchip that can later be scanned and identified if the animal is found.

Temperament is key

Dr. Judith McBeth, veterinarian at Fox Ridge Veterinarian Clinic in Oswego, said she sees Labradors fairly often and believes people choose the breed because they are friendly dogs that are good with kids.
