IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

DUE TO the forecasted severe and dangerous cold weather conditions;

AND FOR reasons of public safety and the safety and well-being of county employees in Court facilities, the Chief Judge has ordered that all Court facilities be closed;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all matters set for hearing on January 30, 2019 shall be and the same hereby are continued to February 27, 2019; and that all matters set for hearing on January 31, 2019 shall be and the same hereby are continued to February 28, 2019, or to such other date as may be agreed upon by the parties or upon a new notice for hearing served therein.
