THIS MATTER COMING ON TO BE HEARD concerning the Electoral Board of the Village of Waterman, for the purpose of designating alternate members of the Electoral Board for the limited purpose of conducting hearings on the 18th day of January, 2013, or any continuation of said hearings, on objections to certain nominating petitions pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/10-8 through 5/10-10.

The Court recognizes that, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Election Code, the Mayor is one of the three members of the Electoral Board. The Court further recognizes that the City Clerk, Christina M. Bystry-Busch, would ordinarily be a member of the Electoral Board; however, because of the possibility that the City Clerk will be called upon to testify at the hearing on the objections pending before the Electoral Board, the Electoral Board should have an alternate member of the Electoral Board appointed. Moreover, this Court recognizes that Roger Bosworth, as the senior Trustee of the Board of Trustees would ordinarily be a member of the Electoral Board; however, Mr. Bosworth is out of the state and therefore unable to serve on the Electoral Board. Consequently, the Electoral Board should have a second alternate member of the Electoral Board appointed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Jeff Meyer and Jeff Lewis shall be designated to serve as members of the Electoral Board of the Village of Waterman pursuant to the provisions of 10 ILCS 5/10-9, for the sole and limited purpose of conducting hearings on or about the 18th day of January, 2013, and as thereafter continued from time to time, on objections to certain nominating papers filed with said Board pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/10-8 through 5/10-10
