

In accordance with the provisions of 725 ILCS 5/108A-1, and effective *instanter*, it is ordered that in addition to the judges previously identified in General Order 19-10, Judge Joseph C. Pedersen is granted the authority to issue orders authorizing or approving the use of eavesdropping devices by law enforcement officers or agencies where one party consents to such monitoring.

In accordance with the provisions of 725 ILCS 5/108-1, and effective *instanter*, it is ordered that in addition to the judges previously identified in General Order 19-13, Judge Joseph C. Pedersen is designated and authorized to receive applications for and enter orders authorizing interceptions of private communications pursuant to 725 ILCS 5/108B-1 *et seq.*

In accordance with the provisions of Supreme Court Rule 295, and effective *instanter*, it is ordered that in addition to the associate judges previously identified in General Order 19-12, Judge Joseph C. Pedersen is assigned to hear and determine criminal cases involving offenses punishable by a term of imprisonment of more than one year.
