

ORDINANCE
79-2
AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Gregory T. Olson did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 6th day of February, 1979, A.D. on the site described in the petition and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps and ordinance be amended in the manner required by law; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby rezoned from A1, Special Use for fertilizer plant to include a radio tower repeater station and that the County Clerk be and she is hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map, to show the change in zoning classification:

The South 143.57 feet of the North 477.57 feet of the East 606.80 feet of the Southeast quarter of Section 13, Township 35 North, Range 8 East of the third principal meridian, Seward Township, Kendall County, Illinois and containing 2 acres more or less.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the above special use classification shall be expressly made subject to the following conditions:


1. If the FAA and the FCC permits were obtained, the use would conform to the regulations.
