AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Kendall County Board by motion requested the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and


WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 5th day of June, 1979, A.D. in the Kendall County Office Building, County Board Room and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning Ordinance be amended in manner required by law, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following amendment be made to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance;

SECTION 7.01 - 29a.

ADD: Ready Mix Cement Plants - Providing a legally authorized sand and gravel pit operation exists on the premises for which the special use is sought. Legally authorized means that all prior applicable zoning, Environmental Protection Agency permits, Surface Mine Reclamation permits, and whatsoever other governmental licenses or permits are required as a condition to said special use. The Board shall restrict the use of said operation to the minerals being mined from the premises on which said special use is located and upon depletion of the minerals, the special use shall terminate. Said special use permit may be also terminated upon the termination of any of the above required licenses or permits or zoning classifications.
