AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Kendall County Board by motion requested the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and


WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 30th day of October, 1979 A.D. in the Kendall County Office Building, County Board Room and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning Ordinance be amended in manner required by law, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following amendment be made to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance;


Section 7.01-B Ready-Mix Cement Plants.

ADD: Provided, however, that if minerals required by the operator of any such cement ready-mix plant are not available on the site, such minerals may be brought to the site and processed there.
