

ORDINANCE 78-10
AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Henry B. Cryder did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 27th day of July, 1978, A.D., on the site described in the petition and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps and ordinance be amended in the manner required by law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby rezoned from A1, Agriculture District to A1SU, Agriculture Special Use for a 400 foot tower and that the County Clerk be and she is hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map, to show the change in zoning classification:

East half of southwest quarter of southeast quarter of northwest quarter of Section 34 of T 36N, Range 8 East, consisting of 5 acres, Na-Au-Say Township, County of Kendall, State of Illinois.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the above special use classification shall be expressly made subject to the following conditions:

1. If the application is denied by the FCC and/or the FAA, the special use will be discontinued and the zoning revert back to A1 District.
