

ORDINANCE  
77-7  
AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Rollin Brooks did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted January 16, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 30th day of August, 1977, A.D., and on the 29th day of September, 1977, A.D. on the site described in the petition and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps and ordinance be amended in the manner required by law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby rezoned from A1, Agricultural District to R1, Single Family District and that the County Clerk be and she is hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map, to show the change in zoning classification:

That part of the South half of the Southeast quarter of Section 5, Township 36 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Waish-Kee-Shaw Reservation in the Northeast quarter of Section 8, Township and Range aforesaid; thence Northerly along the East line of said Reservation 691.68 feet; thence Southeasterly along a line forming an angle of  $80^{\circ}25'$  measured counter-clockwise from the last described course 435.60 feet; thence Northerly along a line forming an angle of  $79^{\circ}09'$  measured clockwise from the last described course 304 feet for the point of beginning; thence Easterly along a line forming an angle of  $88^{\circ}24'$  measured counter-clockwise from the last described course 365.0 feet; thence Northerly along a line forming an angle of  $90^{\circ}0'$  measured clockwise from the last described course 575.0 feet; thence Westerly along a line forming an angle of  $90^{\circ}0'$  measured clockwise from the last described course 450.0 feet; thence southerly along a line forming an angle of  $90^{\circ}0'$  measured clockwise from the last described course 575.0 feet; thence Easterly along a line forming an angle of  $90^{\circ}0'$  measured clockwise from the last described course 85.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 5.94 acres, in the Township of Na-Au-Say, Kendall County, Illinois.
