

ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO  
ANIMAL CONTROL ACT

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Kendall County Board as follows:

1. That every owner of a dog four months or more of age shall cause such animal to be registered and shall pay an annual fee for such dog in the sum of \$ 4.00 at the office of Jean P. Brady, Kendall County Clerk or such other place as may be from time to time designated by the Kendall County Board except that individual registration fees will not be required for dogs confined in kennels at all times. The owner of such confined dogs shall pay a registration fee of \$ 15.00 for twenty dogs or less and \$ 7.50 for each additional group of twenty or less dogs based on the maximum number of dogs in said kennel at any one time upon payment of the required fee, a registration certificate shall be issued.

2. Any person violating or aiding in or abetting violation of the terms of this Ordinance is guilty of a petty offense for a first or second offense and shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor not more than \$200.00 and for a third and subsequent offense is guilty of a Class C misdemeanor. Each day a person fails to comply constitutes a separate offense.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in accordance with law.
