AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Ruth Stoudt and Loren Miller did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted May 10, 1960, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 4th of January, A.D. 1973 on the site described in the petition and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps and ordinance be amended in the manner required by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby rezoned from "B-4" to "M-1" and that the County Clerk be and she is hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map, to show the change in zoning classification:

That part of the Southeast quarter of Section 16, Township 37 North, Range 7 East of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Southeast quarter; thence South 87 degrees 43' 32" West 86.96 feet for the point of beginning; thence South 0 degrees 37' East 99.09 feet; thence South 87 degrees 43' 32" West 105.25 feet; thence North 59 degrees 06' West 105.21 feet to the center line of Cannonball Trail; thence Northeasterly along said center line, being along a curve to the right

having a radius of 3437.7 feet, a distance of 57.08 feet  
to the North line of said Southeast quarter; thence North  
87 degrees 43' 32" East along said North line 156.97 feet to  
the point of beginning; containing 0.37 acres; in the  
Township of Bristol, Kendall County, Illinois.
