AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Michael Eich and Mary Jane Eich did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted May 10, 1960,
and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 2nd day of May, A.D., 1973 on the site described in the petition and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning maps and ordinance be amended in the manner required by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby rezoned from "A" Agricultural District to "R-3" Residential District and that the County Clerk be and she is hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map, to show the change in zoning classification:

That part of the Northeast quarter of Section 26,
Township 37 North, Range 8 East of the third Principal Meridian, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of said Section 26 for a point of beginning; thence N. 0° 15' 00" E. along the West line of said Northeast quarter, 250.86 feet; thence S. 89° 31' 37" E., parallel with the South line of said Northeast quarter, 137.69 feet; thence S. 0° 13' 43" W., 17.86 feet; thence S. 89° 31' 37" E., parallel with the

South line of said Northeast quarter, 300.05 feet;
thence S. 0° 15' 00" E., parallel to the West line
of said Northeast quarter, 233.00 feet to a point
in the South line of the said Northeast quarter;
thence N. 89° 31' 37" W. along said South line of
the Northeast quarter, 437.76 feet to the point of
beginning, all in the Township of Oswego, Kendall
County, Illinois.
