

BASIC FIRE PREVENTION CODE

ORDINANCE NO. 73-14

An ordinance prescribing regulations consistent with nationally recognized standards for safeguarding, to a reasonable degree, of life and property from the hazard of fire and explosion arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices; and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the use or occupancy of buildings or premises; known as the Fire Prevention Code and repealing existing ordinance if any, of the County of Kendall, in the State of Illinois.

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF FIRE PREVENTION CODE.

That a certain document, one (1) of which is on file in the office of the County Clerk of the County of Kendall, being marked and designated as "The BOCA Fire Prevention Code, Second Edition, 1970", as published by The Building Officials Conference of America, Inc. is hereby adopted as the Fire Prevention Code of the County of Kendall in the State of Illinois; for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations; provisions, penalties, conditions, and terms of the BOCA Basic Fire Prevention Code, Second Edition, 1970, are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part thereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance.

SECTION 2. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCE REPEALED.

That the building Ordinance of the County of Kendall, State of Illinois, as adopted November 15, 1955 A.D. and subsequently amended, entitled Building Ordinance, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SAVING CLAUSE.

That nothing in this ordinance or in the Fire Prevention Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights, acquitted or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinances hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. DATE OF EFFECT.

That the County Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
