

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
"AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO PUBLIC
HEALTH ESTABLISHING RULES REGULATING
WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS AND SEWAGE DIS-
POSAL SYSTEMS"

WHEREAS, the County of Kendall has heretofore adopted an Ordinance substituting the Kendall County Zoning and Building office for the Kendall County Health Department in regard to An Ordinance Pertaining to Public Health Establishing Rules Regulating Water Supply Systems and Sewage Disposal Systems; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kendall through the Health Department has now hired personnel currently working with the Kendall County Zoning and Building office performing the duties as described in the aforesaid Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County of Kendall that the Kendall County Zoning and Building Department and the Kendall County Health Department have concurrent jurisdiction in regard to the aforesaid Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED as follows:

1. That the Kendall County Health Department be, and the same is hereby given concurrent jurisdiction with the Kendall County Zoning and Building Department in regard to An Ordinance Pertaining to Public Health Establishing Rules Regulating Water Supply Systems and Sewage Disposal Systems.

2. That this Ordinance is effective for the above purpose only and in no manner repeals or modifies the aforesaid Ordinance except as stated in Section 1 above.
