AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED


WHEREAS, Gordon L. Snyder, did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted May 10, 1960, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 15th day of February, A.D. 1972 on the site described in the petition and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted in favor of recommending to the Board of Supervisors of Kendall County, Illinois that the petition be granted and the Zoning Maps and ordinance be amended in the manner required by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Kendall County, Illinois that the following described property be and it is hereby rezoned from "A" Agricultural District to "R-1" Single Family Residence District with "Special Use Permit" under "R-1" for a commercial radio station on parcels 1,2, and 3 of property now known as Snyder's Subdivision; and that the County Clerk be and she is hereby ordered and directed to change the zoning map, to show the change in zoning classification:

All of Lot 8 of Walter S. Otto's Assessment plat in the Southwest Quarter of Section 10, in Township 37 North, Range 6 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Little Rock Township, Kendall County, Illinois, except the East 1910.53 feet of said Lot 8, containing 24.86 acres, together with all improvements thereon.
