AMENDING KENDALL COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Samuel McVicker and Barbara McVicker did petition the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kendall County for a public hearing in the manner required by law and the ordinances of Kendall County, Illinois for a proposed amendment to the Kendall County Zoning Ordinance adopted May 10, 1960,

and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did thereupon publish notice of a hearing on said proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance as provided by the Statutes of the State of Illinois, and did then hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment on the 27th day of October, A.D. 1972, on the site descirbed in the petition and at the conclusion of said hearing said Zoning Board of Appeals voted to deny this petition and recommend to the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois that this petition be denied.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Kendall County,
Illinois that the following described property not be rezoned:

That part of the Northwest quarter of Section 16 and the Northeast quarter of Section 17, Township 37 North, Range 7 East of the Third Principal Meridien, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Section; thence South 88° 44' west along the north line fo said Section 17, 28.30 feet to the west line of State Route No. 47 and the point of beginning; thence continuing along said north line 213.30 feet; thence south 0° 07' west parallel with the east line of said section 17, 721.70 feet; thence north 89° 49' east parallel with the south line of the Northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 17, 273.56 feet to the

aforesaid west line of state route No. 47; thence Northerly along said West line 727.95 feet to the point of beginning, in Bristol Towsnhip, Kendall County Illinois.
