I offer my deepest sympathy to you for your loss. The information on this document is designed to help answer some of the questions you might have at this time.

The Coroner's Office is required by the laws of the State of Illinois to conduct an investigation regarding any sudden, suspicious, violent or unexpected deaths or deaths that might be considered a threat to public health and safety. As a result of our investigation, we have determined that your loved one's passing is natural in nature, and therefore we will refer this case to their attending physician for final determination of cause of death based on their medical history.

At this time the family is asked to contact the funeral home of their choice. The funeral director will guide you in making any necessary arrangements, and can assist you in obtaining the number of death certificates you will need.

If you require additional certified death certificates at a later time, they can be obtained from the Kendall County Clerk's Office (111 W. Fox Street, Yorkville, IL 60560 | 630-553-4104) or by contacting your funeral director who can order additional copies for you.

TO HELP YOU PREPARE for your visit to the funeral home, the following is a list of question you will need to answer, and items the funeral home may need to have, depending on your choice of services:

- Last Residence
- Date of marriage and location (city & state)
- Souse's name (of deceased), date of death
- Occupation
- Place of employment
- Social security number
- Education (highest grade completed)
- Birth date and location (city and state or country)
- Religion
- Member of which church, clubs, and organizations
- Veteran – name of war, branch of service and date of discharge
- Father's name
- Mother's maiden name
- Survivor's names: spouse, parents, children, brothers, sisters, grandchildren
- Visitation date, hour and location
- Funeral date, hour and location
- Cemetery name and location (city, county and state)
- Picture for newspaper, website and hairdresser
- Memorial instructions
- Pallbearers' names
- Clothing, including underwear, socks, dentures and glasses
- Death certificates – number of certified copies needed for family members, insurance, cars, house, bank accounts, pension funds, etc.
