Kendall County residents can securely buy rabies tags, pay citations, upload rabies certificates, and make donations online!

Rabies vaccination and rabies tags are required in Kendall County for dogs and cats that are 4 months of age or older. Kendall County Animal Control is excited to announce that we have added an online customer payment portal via Illinois epay and a document upload tool to our website. The payment portal and upload tool make it easier for residents to make rabies tag purchases.

The online payment portal and upload tool are easy to use and can be accessed any time, day or night. It is a convenient way for Kendall County residents to upload their veterinarian signed rabies certificate and pay for their dog or cat's rabies tag without having to leave home. Once a resident submits their signed rabies certificate and payment, animal control staff will promptly mail a receipt and their pet's rabies tag to the owner's address.

Online rabies tag purchases are encouraged but not required. Rabies tag purchases for dogs and cats may still be made by mail, after hours drop off or in person by visiting:
