

WHEREAS, when Extended Media Coverage is granted in any particular case, it is necessary for the the designated Media Coordinator to be familiar with the court proceedings and the court filings in the proceeding, in order to know of future court dates other matters germane to the reporting on such matters; and

WHEREAS, in order to be able to accomplish such task, and if necessary, be able to communicate such information to other members of the media in fulfillment of the duties of the Media Coordinator, it would be appropriate for the Media Coordinator to have access to the Circuit Clerk's Case Management System for the purpose of viewing the electronic case file including the viewing of filed documents which are available for viewing if an individual came into the Office of the Circuit Clerk to view the physical court file.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED upon entry of an order granting extended media coverage and designating a Media Coordinator, the Circuit Clerk shall assign to the media coordiantor a unique identifying number which may then be used to register for E-Magnus Multicourt, which then provides access to the Circuit Clerk's Case Managment System.
