Commissioner Kellogg requested that a policy be presented for the retention of capital funds by the District in order to support the upfront costs for future grant requests.

IX. HR, Accounting and Preserve Reservations Manager Restructuring Proposal and Comparative Costs Analysis

Director Guritz presented an HR, Accounting and Preserve Reservations Manager restructuring proposal and comparative cost analysis. Direction was received to present the restructure proposal to the Committee of the Whole.

X. Medical Benefits – FY21 Projected Costs and Contingency Appropriations Transfers

Director Guritz presented an updated medical benefits cost report showing FY21 projected costs.

XI. FY21 Proposed Budget Amendments

Director Guritz presented the FY21 proposed budget amendments. Because the District is amending the budget, GL line item proposals where overages are anticipated were increased, which will allow the District to retain a contingency for the remainder of the fiscal year.
