The 23rd Judicial Circuit, consisting of DeKalb and Kendall Counties announces that a new Associate Judge has been selected to fill the vacancy created by the appointment of Judge Marcy L. Buick to Circuit Judge due to the retirement of the Judge Robbin J. Stuckert..

The new Associate Judge is Stephanie P. Klein of Sycamore. Klein is currently in private practice as an attorney in DeKalb County. She was previously an Assistant State's Attorney in DeKalb County. She has been an attorney for 22 years.

Klein is a graduate of the University of Illinois Law School and DePauw University. She, her husband, and their children reside in Sycamore.

A formal investiture ceremony will be held on August 9th at the DeKalb County Courthouse. Klein will begin her judicial career at the Kendall County Courthouse on that day.
