## Part-time Kennel Technician

Kendall County Animal Control seeks a part-time Kennel Technician responsible for giving compassionate and attentive care to the animals as well as maintain a clean, healthy, and safe environment for the animals and the public. Candidates must be very reliable, have good customer service skills and computer experience. Animal handling experience is required. Professional animal care experience is preferred but willing to train the right candidate. Must have the ability to lift 50lbs. The position will not exceed 28 hours per week. Weekday, Weekend & Holiday hours are required. Morning and afternoon hours are required and must be flexible. Valid driver's license with good driving history is required. Must be 18 years or older to be considered for this position.

Duties include but not limited to:

- Clean & sanitize cages and kennels
- Maintain a clean facility by doing dishes, laundry, mopping, etc.
- Administer medication and microchips
- Feed and water the animals
- Transport Animals
- Exercise and socialize the animals
- Perform behavior assessments and temperament testing
- Work with and supervise volunteers
- Data entry
