KENDALL COUNTY COURTS REMAIN OPEN

Although the Kendall County Health Department reports an increase in positivity rates for Covid cases, the Kendall County Courthouse will continue with regular operations. Presiding Judge, Robert Pilmer said, “We encourage the use of remote appearances via Zoom in all courtrooms, to the extent possible. This is available to all individuals and attorneys in most instances, and should be used to help minimize further transmission of the virus.” “The courts are in a better position today compared to March of 2020 when all court proceedings occurred in person,” said Pilmer.
