The new Associate Judge is Sarah Gallagher Chami of Sycamore. She is currently in private practice as an attorney in DeKalb County. She was previously an Assistant State's Attorney in DeKalb County. She has been an attorney for 18 years.

Gallagher Chami is a graduate of the Chicago-Kent College of Law and DePaul University. She, her husband, and their children reside in Sycamore.

A formal investiture ceremony will be held on February 7th at the DeKalb County Courthouse. Gallagher Chami will begin her judicial career at the DeKalb County Courthouse on that day.
