## **Drive Home Safe Driving School and the Kendall County Sheriff's Office \$500 Scholarship**

The Drive Home Safe Driving School and the Kendall County Sheriff's Office will be awarding one (1) scholarship to a Kendall County student wishing to pursue higher education during the 2022-2023 academic year. The student must be enrolled full-time at a certified institution of higher learning within the State of Illinois.

### **Eligibility**

There shall be no restriction on any applicant by reason of race, age, creed, color, sex or national origin. The only limitations are the following:

- **Applicants must be permanent Kendall County, Illinois residents**
- Scholarships are to be utilized at **institutions of higher learning within the State of Illinois**
- Students must be enrolled as a full-time student during the 2022-2023 school year

### **How to Apply**

Fill out the application, complete the written essay and return all documentation to the Sheriff's Office by March 15, 2022 (must be postmarked by this date)

### **Distribution of Monies**

- The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the school on behalf of the recipient. Funds cannot be used for summer courses and must be used during the 2022-2023 academic year. Scholarship funds are intended to assist students with the cost of tuition, fees and books only.

### **Deadlines**

- The deadline for all application submissions to the Kendall County Sheriff's Office is **March 15, 2022.**
