## KENDALL COUNTY ELDERLY AND DISABLED VOTERS

Please be advised that the following voting aids are available to assist elderly and handicapped voters in the General Election November 8, 2022:

<u>AUTOMARK</u>: Allows handicapped and elderly voters to vote independently and in private with this ballot marking device.

MAGNIFIERS: To assist voters who have visual problems.

<u>HANDICAPPED VOTING BOOTH:</u> For voters who must vote from a seated position.

<u>VOTING ASSISTANCE:</u> Handicapped and Elderly voters requiring help may be assisted by a friend, relative or by the Election Judges.

<u>CURBSIDE VOTING:</u> Available for voters who are physically unable to enter the polling place. Call the Kendall County Voter Registration Office at 630-553-4105 for information.

<u>VOTER REGISTRATION:</u> Call the Kendall County Voter Registration Office at 630-553-4105 for locations throughout the county for the Registrar nearest you, or if special arrangements need to be made.

<u>VOTE BY MAIL:</u> Voters who wish to cast a Vote by Mail Ballot may contact the Kendall County Voter Registration Office 630-553-4105 to obtain the necessary forms.

<u>EARLY VOTING:</u> Voters may contact the Kendall County Voter Registration Office 630-553-4105 to receive directions and hours of the Early Voting locations if voting in person.
