Brief Description of Presence:

The Conservation Foundation (TCF) has spent decades caring for the land, water, and communities within Kendall County. TCF protects land in partnership with the Kendall County Forest Preserve District, cities/villages, and private landowners by facilitating preservation and stewardship. TCF protects water by organizing litter cleanups, promoting native plantings and green infrastructure, hosting community presentations, and providing additional watershed outreach and education. TCF further encourages healthy communities by organizing restoration work days, guiding environmentally-friendly practices through our Conservation@Home and Conservation@Work programs, and supporting municipal conservation efforts through the 'Conservation In Our Community' program. Additional partners include: chambers of commerce, local businesses, park districts, and other non-profit organizations throughout Kendall County. TCF's Kendall County office is located at the historic Dickson-Murst Farm. Prior to the pandemic, community events were held there to provide agricultural and land stewardship education, including: Spring at the Farm, youth Farm Camp, Day at the Farm, and Beer, Bands, and Barns music event. These family-friendly events attract hundreds of people to the farm and surrounding area. The farm buildings are maintained by the Dickson-Murst Farm Partners, a volunteer group of TCF. This year, the full lineup of events will be held for the first time since 2019.

We did not cease to operate at any point during the pandemic.

We did receive grants from Paycheck Protection Program: \$306,000,Other, please specify:: USDA agricultural COVID relief, \$35,485.

We did not receive any funding from Kendall County in the last 5 years.

We did not receive funds for COVID Relief from another county, municipality, or other local government.

We did change how we did business during the pandemic: The Conservation Foundation had to dramatically shift the way we connected and supported people and communities throughout the pandemic. We shifted to virtual events whenever possible (which included creating our online education platform 'ConservationOnline' available to the public via YouTube) and canceled most in-person events. We hosted our largest fundraising event in 2020, the Earth Day Benefit Dinner, entirely online, canceled the Dickson-Murst Farm events that drew large crowds, hosted virtual community engagement presentations, and reduced our land stewardship volunteer opportunities. Most staff also worked remotely to maintain safety and social distancing.

Organization's experience during the Covid Pandemic:

TCF was able to successfully carry on our mission and readily adapt to the situation, although we were impacted by a reduced community presence, altered outreach, reduction of donor stewardship, and reduced volunteer engagement. During the
