## 7 Year Sentence for Delivery of LSD

Kendall County State's Attorney Eric Weis announced that Timothy Nielsen (dob: 08/29/96, 326 Standish St, #1) of Elgin, Illinois was sentenced to 7 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections by the Honorable Robert Pilmer on the charge of Unlawful Delivery of a Controlled Substance, a Class X Felony, in a negotiated plea agreement.

According to State's Attorney Weis, Nielsen delivered over 15 hits of LSD to an undercover police officer working with the Kendall County Police Assistance Team in September of 2021. As the investigation unfolded, an arrest warrant was issued for Nielsen in December of 2021, was promptly arrested and has remained in custody since that time.

Nielsen has 2 previous convictions for possession of controlled substance and a conviction for delivery of cannabis in Dekalb County. Nielsen will serve 18 months of mandatory supervised release upon completion of his sentence in the Illinois Department of Corrections. The case was prosecuted by Assistant State's Attorney Ryan Phelps. Nielsen was represented by the Public Defender's Office.
