The new Associate Judge is Carlo D. Colosimo. He is currently in practice as an attorney in Kendall County. He has been an attorney since 1999.

Carlo is a graduate of Northern Illinois University's College of Law and Illinois State University where he obtained his undergraduate degree in Political Science.

A formal investiture ceremony will be held on August 19, 2022 at the Kendall County Courthouse.
