6 Year Sentence for Delivery of Controlled Substance

Kendall County State's Attorney Eric Weis announced that Frankie Davila (dob: 08/04/00, 3143 Kenilworth Ave.) of Berwyn, Illinois was sentenced to 6 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections by the Honorable Robert Pilmer on the charge of Unlawful Delivery of a Controlled Substance, a Class 1 Felony, as part of a negotiated plea agreement last week. Judge Robert Pilmer accepted the proposed sentence which will start on January 19, 2023.

Davila was charged back in 2020 when he delivered approximately just under 5 grams of cocaine to an undercover police officer working with the Kendall County Police Assistance Team. After the delivery, Davila was immediately taken into custody by members of KCPAT. Weis commented that the work of our undercover drug task force continues to take drugs and drug dealer off our streets.

Davila will serve 18 months of mandatory supervised release upon completion of his sentence in the Illinois Department of Corrections. The case was prosecuted by Assistant State's Attorney Ryan Phelps and Frank Gorup. The Defendant was represented by Liam Kelly.
