7 Year Sentence for Delivery of Controlled Substance

Kendall County State's Attorney Eric Weis announced that Adam Schulte (dob: 07/27/94, 406 Ogden Falls Blvd.) of Oswego, Illinois was sentenced to 7 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections by the Honorable Robert Pilmer on the charge of Unlawful Delivery of a Controlled Substance, a Class X Felony, in a negotiated plea agreement earlier this month.

According to Weis, Schulte delivered 30 tabs of LSD to an undercover police officer working with the Kendall County Police Assistance Team in February of 2020. As the investigation unfolded, an arrest warrant was issued for Schulte and he was taken into custody shortly after the warrant was issued. Schulte has remained in custody since being apprehended in March of this year.

Schulte will serve 18 months of mandatory supervised release upon completion of his sentence in the Illinois Department of Corrections. The case was prosecuted by Assistant State's Attorney Ryan Phelps and Frank Gorup. The Defendant was represented by the Public Defender's Office.
