Any registered voter who is physically incapable of going to the polls on Election Day may apply to the County Clerk for a ballot to be voted at home. The vote may be cast by either the Vote by Mail or Disabled Voter Programs. An individual admitted to a hospital, nursing home or rehabilitation center, within 14 days of the election is eligible for the Hospitalized Voter Program. Pre-arranged Curbside Voting is also available for voters who are physically unable to enter the polling place.
