WHEREAS, On November 1, 2022, the Supreme Court adopted Rule 45 pertaining to Remote Appearances in Circuit Court Proceedings (revised February 1, 2023);


WHEREAS, in compliance with the direction of SCR 45, the Circuit Judges of the 23rd Judicial Circuit enacted Local Rule 2023-01, effective March 31, 2023;

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of Local Rule 2023-01, Kendall County had published a certain Policy on Remote Court Appearances (effective June 2020) and had enacted Administrative Order 20-19 for the purpose of setting forth guidelines and procedures pertaining to remote appearances.

WHEREAS, the procedures adopted by Local Rule 2023-01 now operate to supersede both the existing Kendall County Policy on Remote Court Appearances and the prior procedures for remote appearances within Kendall County as set forth in Administrative Order 20-19.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, subject to the overall administrative authority of the Illinois Supreme Court set forth in Supreme Court Rule 21 and pursuant to the specific authority granted by Local Rule 1.35-01, effective with the adoption of Local Rule 2023-01, the Kendall County Policy on Remote Appearances (effective June 2020) is rescinded and Administrative Order 20-19 is repealed.
