Vote-by-Mail: First day to request is August 7, 2024

(Note: September 26, 2024, is the first day the Election Authority may begin mailing vote-by-mail ballots)

Early Voting: September 26, 2024

**Grace Period Registration & Voting: October 9, 2024** 

Election Day Voting: November 5, 2024

Any registered voter who is physically incapable of going to the polls on Election Day may apply to the County Clerk for a ballot to be voted at home. The vote may be cast by either Vote-by-Mail or Disabled Voter Programs. An individual admitted to a hospital, nursing home or rehabilitation center, within 14 days of the election is eligible for the Hospitalized Voter Program. Pre-arranged Curbside Voting is also available for voters who are physically unable to enter the polling place. Please contact the Kendall County Election Office at 630.553.4105 for information.
